***NOTE FOR ALL IAPS WORKSHOPS:** You must bring your own portable easel, and a board to support your paper. The room will be set with chairs which can be moved around to suit your preference. You can stand at an easel and use the table for your supplies, or you can bring a table easel and sit to work. Rubbing Alcohol will be provided for the students' use. **IMPORTANT:** Please bring a plastic or cloth sheet to place under your easel, or table, to protect the hotel's carpet.*

Sergei Pietila's SUGGESTED MATERIALS LIST:

1. The photos of those landscapes you are going to paint. They will be used for reference in your work. These photos must contain a big number of dark spots and shadows.
2. At least 3 sheets of dark paper of different shades (your choice). The size of those sheets should be A2 or bigger. You should use the paper brands that you are used to (your favorite ones).
3. You will need charcoal (drawing wood, unpreserved)
4. Pastels. You should choose your favorite ones.
5. You should also bring erasers, wet wipes and pastel pencils with you.
